STANDARDS OF PRACTICE CODES**

POLICY STATEMENT ON VISITING LECTURERS

September 2008

**IT IS THE POLICY OF THE CHIROPRACTORS REGISTRATION BOARD OF
VICTORIA THAT:-**

1. All visiting lecturers, including those from overseas, who intends to include a “hands-on” component in his/her lecture, seminar or talk, is required to be registered.
2. The appropriate form is that for Conditional Registration.
3. For Practitioners registered in another jurisdiction in Australia or New Zealand, no 100 point check is required.
4. Practitioners coming from overseas will be required to provide the 100 point check, as well as evidence of their registration in their home country.
5. All Practitioners are required to provide details of what insurance cover they have for the time that they are in Victoria.
6. Such registration to be facilitated as a matter of urgency.
7. No fee will be charged for such registration

Note: “hands-on” refers to the lecturer applying his or her hands on one or more others at the lecture, seminar or talk. That is, this refers to chiropractic techniques being taught by the use of hands-on demonstrations by the lecturer.
