Previously recognised Qualifications

In addition to the above programs, the Board will continue to recognise those qualifications held by Practitioners currently registered to enable them to maintain their registration. However, the Board may not accept these qualifications for Practitioners seeking registration for the first time, or seeking restoration after a prolonged absence from Australia.

These include:-

- 11 Practitioners Grandfathered under the provisions of the Chiropractors and Osteopaths Act of 1978 who have maintained their registration consistently since initial registration.
- B. App. Sc. (Chiro) conferred by the Phillip Institute of Technology and later by RMIT.
- Bachelor of Applied Science (Clinical Science) and Bachelor of Chiropractic Science
- Doctor of Chiropractic conferred by various Colleges in Melbourne now defunct.
- Doctor of Chiropractic conferred by the Sydney College of Chiropractic.
- Diploma of Chiropractic conferred by the Chiropractic College of Australasia.
